How to apply to i-STEM


To attend i-STEM, participants must apply through Idaho STEM Action Center Grant Portal (NOTE: i-STEM is no longer first-come-first-serve). All applications are blind reviewed by two anonymous reviewers. Placement into a strand is based on application score and participant's top three choices indicated in the application.

Once participants are accepted and placed into a strand, they will receive an email from Idaho STEM Action Center with a link to pay their registration fee online. Participants must pay their registration fees by April 15th to reserve their spot. No refunds.


How to create an account in the Grants Portal:

Visit stem.idaho.gov/grants/


Click on "Create a New Account"




Enter your first name, last name, and the email address associated with your organization. For the organization, only enter the first three letters of your school or organization. Hit Submit.




Select your organization and click "Continue." If you do not find your organization, try again. All public schools and libraries should already exist. If you cannot find your organization, you may input your organization's information to create a new account, or you may email grants@stem.idaho.gov and we can help you create an account.






After you have selected or created your organization, create a password for your account by typing it into the "Password" box and confirm. Click "Submit" and you will receive an email welcoming you to the portal.




How to access and fill out the i-STEM application:

Visit stem.idaho.gov/grants/


Click on "Login to Grants Portal to Apply"




Log into your account.



Click on "Apply"




Select the i-STEM 2019 Participant Application in the list and click the "Apply" button on the right side.
