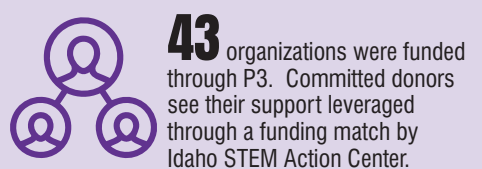
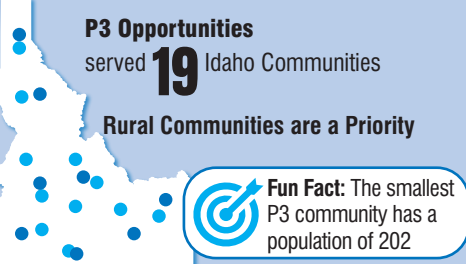
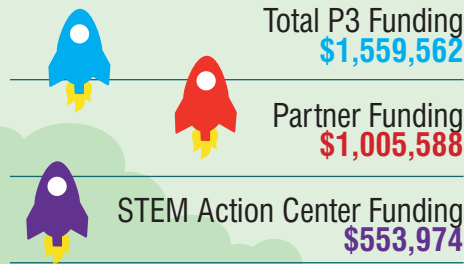

P3 funding expanded access to STEM learning opportunities at schools, museums, libraries, student clubs, and out-of-school programs

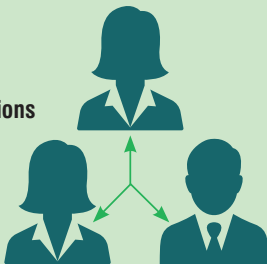

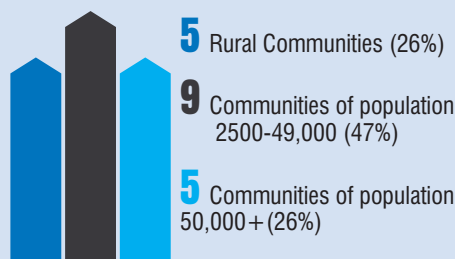

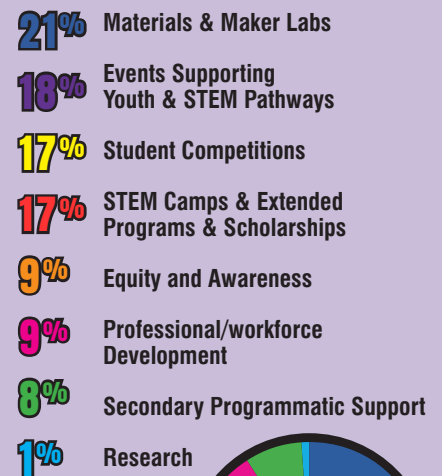
