Deadline: March 31, 2022

Eligibility

- Must be graduating with a STEM Diploma in accordance with IC 33-523 by spring 2022
- Must be attending a public high school in Idaho
- Must be pursuing education/training in one of the STEM fields listed below
- Must be enrolling full time in an Idaho public post-secondary institution (university, community college or career technical school) in the summer/fall of 2022
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above for all classwork for the three semesters prior to submitting this application

Required Application Materials

- Completed application
- Copy of your current high school transcript
- List of STEM courses that apply toward the STEM Diploma
- Two signed letters of recommendation
- A type-written essay (12pt/double spaced) in response to the following prompt: *Describe your STEM journey and why you want to pursue a career in STEM. (Maximum 7500 characters)*

Application Instructions

- Complete pages 1 & 2 of this application and attach the required application materials listed above.
- **Combine ALL materials into one, single PDF attachment.** We recommend printing each required document, compiling them in the order listed above and scanning them to create one PDF document. Google docs will not be accepted.
- Email the completed PDF application to John McFarlane no later than 11:59pm MDT on March 31, 2022. Late/incomplete applications will not be considered.
