

FY22 Public-Private Partnership (P3) Rubric

Checklist for applicants (minimum qualifications for statewide/strategic P3 application):

- ✓ Partner funding support to run through STEM AC/Foundation is a minimum of \$5,000
- ✓ Program impact is anticipated to reach statewide, across multiple regions, or have a model/plan that can be easily replicated across the state
- ✓ Aligns with identified strategic priorities or meets identified needs across the state
- ✓ May have timeline requirements outside of typical procedures
- OR-
- ✓ Applicant has received an invitation to apply from STEM AC

Program partner involvement	30	Program partners, especially industry partners, are deeply involved in achieving program outcomes, providing volunteers, mentors, or other human-power support, and/or are deeply involved in program design and rollout. Broadening Participation (Impact on underserved populations)	20	Program proposal presents a plan for broadening participation and enhancing or improving access/outcomes for underserved populations in STEM that is well-researched to include promising practices.	Program proposal identifies underserved populations in STEM to reach with this program. The plan for doing so is unclear or relies on efforts outside of the program organizers.	Program proposal does not have a plan to broaden participation to include underserved populations in STEM, or plan does not include clear efforts at reaching these populations.
Program design & goals	20	Program design and/or goals aim to equip participants with the skills and knowledge they need to pursue higher-level STEM pathways, including clear, effective plans to measure related outcomes.	Program design and/or goals may be limited to awareness-related efforts, rather than on developing skills or knowledge. Program may also be limited to brief, singular events (i.e. STEM nights, conferences, etc). Plans to achieve and measure outcomes may likewise be limited.	Program design and/or goals may be limited to obtaining or developing materials, rather than on the use of such materials (i.e. capital campaigns, consumables, etc). Plans to achieve and measure outcomes may likewise be limited.

Replicability/Sustainability of program	20	Program proposal can be replicated to a new location, new population and/or with new partners. There is a plan to sustain the program into the future.	Program proposal describes replicability or sustainability of the program but not both.	Program proposal cannot be replicated to new locations, populations, or partners nor is a plan identified for sustaining the program.
New Applicant or Project	10	First-time programs, pilot projects, creative or novel partnerships, and other projects or programs that demonstrate potential for strengthening of the proposed partnerships in the future. ("First-time program")	Established programs and/or partnerships that demonstrate a strengthening partnership beyond funding, which may have received funding from this opportunity in the past.	Programs and/or partnerships that have received funding from this opportunity in the past. ("Return program")
