



Idaho's STEM Scholarship

INVEST IN IDAHO'S FUTURE by contributing to STEM scholarships for Idaho high school seniors who will be attending Idaho post-secondary institutions, including Idaho Community and Technical Colleges.

Ten one-time, \$2,000 scholarships awarded each May in the following categories:

Advanced Manufacturing - Agriculture - Computer Science/Technology - Engineering - Food Sciences - Health Sciences Mathematics - Natural Sciences - General STEM (2)

Why

- In 2020, on average there were 2,000 unfilled STEM jobs per month in Idaho.
- STEM jobs pay twice as much on average as non-STEM jobs.
- Within 10 years, 90% of jobs will require digital skills.
- Since 1980, Idaho's tuition and higher education fees have increased nearly six-fold.
- State funding and support during that time for in-state student tuition has dropped nearly 40%. (Idaho Center for Fiscal Policy 2019).

Qualifications

- Graduate with an Idaho STEM Diploma
- Will be attending an Idaho post-secondary institution including career technical schools
- Minimum high school cumulative GPA of 3.0

Contributions

The minimum contribution is \$1,000 for organizations/businesses and \$500 for individuals.

Recognition

For their contributions, donors will be recognized on the STEM AC website, in the STEM AC and STEM EcosySTEM newsletters, and through STEM AC social media.

Reward current STEM scholars and incentivize younger students to pursue a STEM education.
