- Form 990 submitted on time by November 15, 2022. No extension was needed this year.
- Form 3115 documenting accounting change submitted; changed from accrual basis to cash basis
- Molly thanked all who helped with the Form 990 filing.
- Foundation projected budget is \$1,200,000.
- Foundation checks will be signed monthly going forward to move money from the Foundation to the Center.
- Financials were reviewed, fiscal year to date
- Laurie thanked Molly for all her work on getting the Form 990 submitted on time.

Executive Director update:

Laurie emailed the press release to the board announcing Caty Solace as Director of the Idaho
STEM Action Center to board members. Her role begins in December as Director of STEM AC and
ED of STEM AC Foundation.

Current Business and Foundation Updates

- New grant awards since last meeting from State Farm Foundation (\$11,000, i-STEM) and Whittenberger Foundation (\$6,644, IDX).
- Several grant applications submitted and awaiting notification--\$50,000 total.
- Fundraising: Currently at \$232,722, prospect for calendar year end of \$275,000.
- Current focus is Hour of Code volunteer support goal is to have 20 companies and schools
- We have the companies lined up and now matching them to schools

- Laurie is willing to help with organizing and requested list of schools so board members can request to participate
- Program sponsorships document posted to website. Joanna to send PDF out to board
- Year-end giving is coming up! Giving Tuesday is November 29. Year-end giving through December 31.
