STEM Externships - Summer Externships for Classroom Teachers and Career CounselorsWhat do students actually know about local businesses and the future workplaces they offer?

The STEM Action Center, in partnership with the Workforce Development Council, provides K-12 classroom teachers and college and career advisors the opportunity to extern with local businesses over the summer. This program places selected externs with companies to work on projects related to their area of expertise and requires educators to complete 200 hours of on-site, experiential learning to take back to their classrooms and students. Idaho Science & Engineering Fairs MARCH 2023



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STEM AWARDS PROGRAMS

The Idaho STEM School Designation Program

Supports certification and recognition for schools or programs that provide high-quality, inter-disciplinary, multi-grade STEM education based on the 16 Cognia STEM School Standards. This designation recognizes schools that provide rich STEM learning experiences for students, educators, and communities. It defines best practices for STEM schools and with consistent criteria by which schools can measure their progress toward designation. Idaho STEM Action Center partners can support a school as it progresses on its path towards STEM Designation. Be a part of building a STEM School and make a difference for an entire community!



STEM Diploma Scholarships

Donate to STEM ScholarshipsStudents in Idaho who earn a STEM Diploma are eligible to apply for a \$3,000 scholarship, provided they will be attending an Idaho post-secondary institution, including career technical schools, and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. The STEM Scholarships will be offered in the following fields: Advanced Manufacturing, Agriculture, Computer Science/Technology, Engineering, Food Sciences, Health Sciences, Mathematics, Natural Sciences, and General STEM (2). The STEM Scholarship application opens each fall for students to apply. Selected applicants are awarded by April 15th. STEM AC awards a minimum of 10 students each year. Your partnership makes this opportunity possible for more Idaho students.


